We also nurture the next generation through a Kids Garden Project, where children explore nature and farming in a fun and educational way.

OUR GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

- Marginalised women and their families grow more nutritious organic foods through sustainable farming methods.
- Women gain knowledge and skills to run their own agribusinesses.
- Through Cooperatives and Farm Days, women form support systems and networks that encourage collaboration, mentorship and resilience.
- Preschool children in the Kids Garden Project develop an early life skills and environmental awareness.
- The farming techniques will improve soil health, reduce waste and promote biodiversity.
